




Are you sacrificing?

If yes, set your intention! Do not cut your hair or nails from the 1st of Dhul Hijjah until after the sacrifice on the day of Eid.




Salah

Recite the Quran and try to do Tadabbur.




The first 10 days of Dhul Hijjah are the greatest days of the year.

These are the good deeds you can do in these 10 days.


Sadaqah

The rewards are immense in these 10 days. Give as much as you can.




Fasting

Make sure to fast on 9th of Dhul Hijjah (The day of Arafah).





Dua & Dhikr



Hajj Map




Reciting Talbiyah





The story of Hajar AS and Zam Zam water

Each of the steps of Hajj is unique and has its own reason for being important. Allah SWT wanted to teach us to put our trust in HIM because HE will give us everything we need.

Hajar was the wife of Prophet Ibrahim AS. Ibrahim AS and Hajar were blessed with a son named Ismail. One day, Hajar was in a desert with her little baby Ismail. They were very thirsty because they didn't have any water left. Hajar didn't give up hope.

She ran back and forth between two hills, Safa and Marwa, seven times, looking for help. Then something amazing happened. Allah SWT sent the angel Jibreel to make water come up from under the earth. Hajar dug and drank from the water and gave some to her baby too.

This special water is called Zam Zam and is still there today after 4000 years. If you ever drink Zam Zam water, make sure to make Dua! Hajar's story teaches us to have trust in Allah SWT and never give up, even when things are hard. It also reminds us how much mothers love their children.








The Story of Prophet Ibrahim AS



Prophet Ibrahim AS was born in the kingdom of Babylon. He was born into a community that practiced paganism. Questioning the worship of idols from a young age, he sought the true creator of the universe. Reflecting on the natural world, he heard the voice of Allah SWT on a mountaintop and submitted his heart to "the Lord of the universe."



As Ibrahim AS spread the message of Allah's oneness, people rejected and threatened him. When the townspeople left for a feast, Ibrahim demolished all their idols except the largest one to show that these idols could not protect themselves.

The people, filled with anger, chained him and threw him into a huge fire, but Allah SWT intervened and commanded the fire to be cool, and Ibrahim was unharmed. The people were amazed and acknowledged that Ibrahim's God saved him.




Years later, Ibrahim AS dreamt that he must sacrifice his beloved son, Ismail AS. Obeying this command as a test of faith, he took Ismail to Mount Arafat. When Ibrahim explained his dream, Ismail agreed.

Just as Ibrahim was about to perform the sacrifice, Allah SWT intervened, declaring, "O Ibrahim! You have fulfilled the vision and now you will be rewarded!"


